The Education Endowment and Scholarship Committee is once again offering education scholarships to members of United in Faith. The

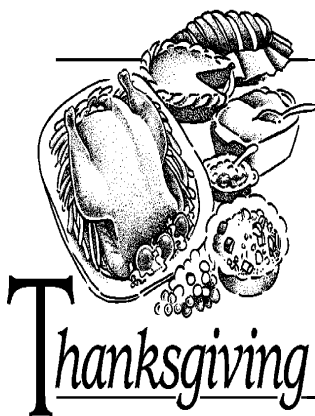
applications are now available and must be completed and returned by no later than December 31, 2009.
