Hello Everyone,

My name is Pete Herberg. I am United in Faith's Church Council President for the next year as we go through what I call a "State of Transition" in our Church. In this newsletter, I will be informing you from time to time where we are within this "State of Transition" process. As you are probably aware, Pastor Carla has moved on to a new position with the Metro Synod. We are going through the beginning stages of the pastoral Call process which involves putting an Interim Pastor in place so that we can begin the discernment of what type of permanent pastoral leadership our congregation needs. The Chicago Metro Synod has already recommended an Interim Pastor to us, who, the church council will be having a "get to know you" meeting with, in early March.

After that meeting, if all goes well, a salary & benefits package will be negotiated and the Synod Bishop will appoint the Interim Pastor. The game plan is to have the Interim Pastor in place before Easter Week begins. After this step is done, a Call Committee will be put together to begin the Permanent Pastoral Call process. If you are interested in serving on the Call Committee, please let me or one of the other Council members know or leave a message with Jeanne in the church office.
