I know how to knit and how to crochet.

I have met knitters and crocheters. I know some of the best. Peaceful, dedicated, disciplined people who pray while they stitch. People who can see the shawl or scarf or sweater in their mind and, motion by motion, twine the yarn into that vision.

I am neither a knitter nor a crocheter. I can't see the final project. I am a plodder. A harried technician. But I make great washcloths. Those wonderful people let me sit with them anyway.

I also know how to pray. But just like Jesus' disciples, I often feel like I don't do it right. Like I'm not enough. Not peaceful enough, not dedicated enough, not disciplined enough. And I can imagine standing there with them, urging, "Teach us to pray!"

Me too! Please—me too!

Jesus didn't scold them. He didn't correct or complicate. He just offered a pattern:

"When you pray, say:

Father, hallowed be your name,

your kingdom come.

Give us each day our daily bread.

Forgive us our sins,

for we also forgive everyone who sins against us.

And lead us not into temptation."

The Lord's Prayer is far better than a washcloth—but the pattern isn't all that different. It's simple. Steady. No fancy stitches. Just the daily bread and butter of faith.

As summer fades and fall settles in, the real knitters and crocheters begin picking yarns for their winter projects. I'm gearing up for washcloth gifts—those humble, useful little squares tucked into stockings and boxes that aren't quite full.

And I'm thinking, too, about my prayers for you. The small, steady motions that connect my heart to yours. The words that keep us woven together in the Spirit's pattern.

When I don't know what to say—when the stitches of prayer slip through my fingers—I start where Jesus told us to start:

Hallowed be your name.

#### Comments:

2025 income from church operations excluding Special Gifts is lower than spending by \$23,413 in September and lower by \$178,605 YTD.

Income includes \$2,673 in Special Estate gifts from:

Anita Perske - \$1,439 in January 2025 Anita Perske - \$530 in March 2025 Rev. Barthel - \$704 in September 2025

Investments returned a gain of \$17,951 for September & a gain of \$97,257 YTD. Educational Investments returned a gain \$5,912 for September & a gain of \$32,959 YTD.

Total expense for September is favorable to budget by \$322 and is favorable to budget by \$15,905 YTD due to the Salaries YTD costs being lower than budget by \$10,521; the Ministry YTD costs being \$2,155 lower than budget; the Administrative YTD costs being \$65 lower than budget, the YTD Building costs being higher than budget by \$20,053; the Benevolence YTD costs being lower than budget by \$3,750 & the Ministry Directors' YTD costs being lower than budget by \$19,468.
